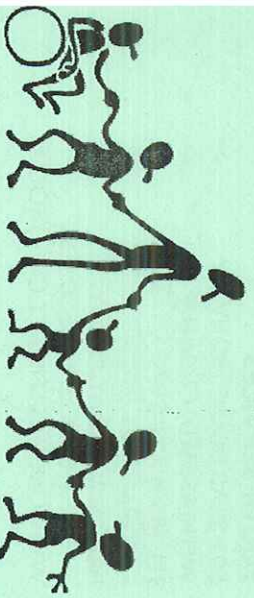


# THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL & YOUTH SERVICES
